Moultonborough to Sell Surplus Equipment & Street Signs

The Town of Moultonborough has set the viewing date and time for its annual surplus sale of obsolete and retired equipment. Interested parties may view the many items on Saturday April 16th from 9 a.m. to Noon at the Highway Garage on Highway Garage Road in Moultonborough. This year's sale will also feature almost 150 street signs rendered obsolete when all were replaced as the result of a new federal regulation dictating larger signs with larger lettering and greater reflectivity. These signs are being offered on a first come first served basis for a fixed price of \$20 apiece in response to a request by some to acquire a sign with a particular meaning to them such as family names.

Other than the street signs, the items are being offered for sale by means of sealed bids. The offering includes a 1997 GMC C7500 Dump with a sander/dump body and plow and wing, a 22' 1984 Imp Boats X230 SC with Mercruiser 260 5-liter engine and tandem axle roller trailer, a 7.5' by 9.5' Yellow Poly Swim Float, a Rosco 1 ton roller, and a variety of line painting machine(s); excess computer equipment, VHF, CB, and electrical equipment, construction barricade warning signs and a variety of other items.

A Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) deposit, in the form of a bank check or money order made payable to the Town of Moultonborough, must accompany each bid which is due on in the Offices of the SelectBoard by 2 p.m. on April 21, 2011. Detailed information on the process, including an explanation of the condition of the items, what accessories are being stripped before transfer and the timing of the transfer for items that may stay in use past the viewing date, such as the fire boat, is available by going to the Town's web site at www.moultonboroughnh.gov and clicking on the button labeled Paid, Volunteer and Contract Opportunities. Bid forms will also be available on the day of the viewing.

Joel Mudgett, chairman of the SelectBoard said, "This process not only helps us dispose of surplus items to those who might be able to give them a second life but lets us return some dollars back to the towns coffers in manner which gives everyone an open opportunity to compete for the items." He noted that this Saturday viewing date had been specifically picked for those who worked week days and could not get to previous sales.
