All surplus property will be sold as is, where is. The Town of Moultonborough makes no express or implied warranties beyond the face thereof, including, but not limited to, “suitability for use”, “merchantability” or “fitness for particular purpose”.

- Indemnification:** The purchaser shall be solely responsible for any loss, claims or damages arising out of the removal or transportation of property from the sale site or the use of the same thereafter. The purchaser further agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Town of Moultonborough against any and all losses, claims or damages arising from the removal or transport of any property, or any other actions arising out of this transaction.
- Bidding:** The bid documents are attached to this solicitation. Additional bid documents will be available at the sale site. **Bids must be submitted to the offices of the SelectBoard in Town Hall or the Town official at the sale location no later than noon on the day of the sale.** Interested bidders are advised to inspect all property prior to submitting their bids (note the inspection date and time in the offer).
- Payment:** The winning bidder(s) will be notified and be required to submit a bank check, made payable to the Town of Moultonborough, for payment of any balance due. Such payment must be delivered, to a location to be directed, where it will be accepted by a Town official. When payment has been received the Town official will authorize the release of the purchased property. Full payment must be made prior to the removal of any property.
- Removal:** Purchased property must be removed within seven (7) business days of the sale. If an item is not removed by this deadline, a storage fee of \$10.00, per day, per item or lot will be assessed. Removal will be allowed only between the hours of 8:00 a.m. to Noon Monday through Thursday. No removal will be permitted on weekends or holidays.
- The Town of Moultonborough is not responsible for damage to sold equipment. Upon payment to the Town of Moultonborough, it is advised that purchased items be removed immediately.
- Deposit:** A Fifty Dollar (\$50.00) deposit in the form of a bank check or money order made payable to the Town of Moultonborough must accompany each bid lot to be applied against any successful bid.
