



Q2 Do you or your spouse own property in Moultonborough?







Q5 Which of the following categories best describes your employment status?





Q10 During your commute, on which Primary road do you travel?







Q13 If yes, what issues regarding the question above would concern you?





Q18 Do you believe that officially designating roads as Scenic Roads is important?









Q29 Do you believe that other towns residents should pay a fee for the use of the Library or Recreation Programs?





Q31 Would you favor establishing a separate "residential use only" zoning district where compatible in Town?







Q34 Would you like to see additional light industrial or high tech development in Town?











Q43 Do you favor continuing the effort to eradicate/control Milfoil (invasive plant species) in our lakes?








Q46 If so, what type?










































