




Paradise Shores now known as Balmoral from 1937 – Interesting how Balmoral was designed, each picture is a Time Capsule

I received these aerial photos dated from 1937-1946, 1954, 1970 and 1982 of the Moultonborough Area from the Town Planner. I have cropped out only the area of what is now known as Balmoral. In the larger pictures you can see the area has no construction or roads shown. Shannon Brook shows as a snake winding its way to the lake. You will notice another smaller brook going from an inlet, then on the left another brook or stream. The larger pictures are below.



Picture 1937-1946 notice the "S" shape which is Shannon Brook and to the left will be Middle Brook AKA (The Canal)



This 1954 picture begins to define some road lines and the white spot is a gravel pit on the other side of Shannon Brook. A clearer picture of the Middle Brook which is known as the Canal and to the left is the inlet which will become the Basin between Myrtle and Blueberry.



The 1970 picture shows where Middle Brook now the Canal had been dredged as well as the Basin between Myrtle and Blueberry, the Canal shows Sunrise Drive while Shannon Brook keeps its shape. The Basin was the small water way pictured in the 1954 frame.



Picture 1982 shows Balmoral as well as Suissevale Roads and homes; upper left shows Lees Mill and part of Lees Pond.
