Addendum Issued May 16, 2016

The following are the addendum items for the Fire apparatus Pumper/Tanker truck bid:

1. Payment terms: Page 4 #5c

This section as originally written is deleted and replaced with the following:

“Any cash payment due to you will be paid in full upon the delivery and acceptance of the Town. The Town will be given sufficient opportunity to inspect, test and evaluate the truck at the Town’s facility prior to acceptance. Any portion of your bid and performance deposit remaining on deposit with the Town will be returned at this time.”

2. Page 5 #8 Item A:

The amount of the bid bond or certified check is 1% not 5%.

3. Page 5 #8. Item B

A 100% performance bond will be acceptable if the bidder is or is not the manufacturer of the chassis.

4. Page 6 #9 Financing:

This section is amended as follows:

“The apparatus to be acquired under this invitation shall be financed by funds raised and appropriated by the Town at the March 2016 Town Meeting under Article 6.

The Town shall make payment in full ~~within thirty (30) days of its~~ upon receipt of the truck and certification by the fire chief; that the apparatus meets specifications and is fully operational.

Should items of correction be needed, the payment will be made ~~within thirty (30) days of~~ upon the corrections having been made and accepted by the Town.”

5. Cab and Chassis-“Cummins ISX-15, 500 HP diesel motor”

International does not offer the Cummins ISX-15 engine in the WorkStar package. The following engine should be supplied.

ENGINE, DIESEL {Navistar N13} 475 HP @ 1850 RPM, 1250 lbft Torque @ 1000 RPM, 2100 RPM Governed Speed

6. Cab and Chassis- "Roof mounted, dual stuttertone air horns w/chain inside cab" NFPA 1901 13.9.2 & 13.9.3 prohibit air horns to be mounted on the roof of apparatus. Air horns shall mounted to be compliant with the NFPA 1901 Standard for Automotive Fire Apparatus

NFPA 1901

13.9.2 - Where furnished, air horns, electric siren(s), and electronic siren speaker(s) shall be mounted as low and as far forward on the apparatus as is practical.

13.9.3 - Audible warning equipment shall not be mounted on the roof of the apparatus.
