

ORDINANCE

TOWN OF MOULTONBOROUGH, NEW HAMPSHIRE

An Ordinance Relative to Jumping Off Bridges

Be it ordained by the Town of Moultonborough, New Hampshire, an ordinance regulating the use of bridges pursuant to RSA 31:39 as follows:

Section 11.1 The following areas are designated by this ordinance:

- a. Long Island Bridge
- b. Black Cat Island Bridge

Section 11.2 It shall be unlawful for anyone to jump, dive or otherwise throw themselves from any bridge in the Town of Moultonborough.

Section 11.3 It shall be unlawful for anyone to throw or discharge or cause to be thrown or discharged any item from any bridge in the Town of Moultonborough.

Section 11.4 For the purposes of this ordinance, "item" excludes any object specifically designed for, or commonly used by, a person for the sport of fishing.

Section 11.5 Violation of any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not less than fifty dollars (\$50.00), and each day of violation shall constitute a separate offense.

This ordinance shall be in effect upon its passage. Passed and approved this 10th day of August, 1989.
