Chair Cristina Ashjian called the meeting to order at 5:30 PM, noting that the Minutes of the March 25th meeting will be approved when more members are present. The Commission briefly discussed summer site visits to barns and other historical properties of interest. The Hancock Associates site plan for housing on Whittier Highway is on the agenda for tonight's Planning Board hearing at 7 PM. The Commission submitted a comment for that application in March.

Members then discussed additions underway to the Commission's town-wide survey project, including summer camps and surveyed archaeological sites. The 2024 survey is now online on the Town website, and the Heritage GIS layer is still under development. Property surveys for 8 Route 25/Lake Shore Drive historic properties in the DOT project area were completed by the Preservation Company, and will be added to the survey spreadsheet and town database.

Cristina noted how the Conservation Commission has requested Heritage assistance with additional signage for the historical and archeological features on the Moultonborough Falls Conservation Area (MFCA) property, with the recently appended parcels on the Red Hill River. The Taking Action for Wildlife (TAFW) team from UNH Cooperative Extension will provide assistance for this effort over the summer months through the community assistance program.
