The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

### **Administration**

**Assessing:** Whitney Consulting Group (WCG) has provided the *preliminary values* for the 2023 town-wide revaluation. Informal hearings will be held Monday, August 28<sup>th</sup> thru Friday, September 1<sup>st</sup>. The letters with the preliminary values and details for scheduling a hearing time, were mailed out on August 10<sup>th</sup>. Hard copies of the preliminary values can be viewed in the town hall lobby and at the library. Electronic copies can be found on the town website – Assessor – Value Update Information. ### **Department of Public Works**

**Facilities/Grounds:** The Facilities and Grounds crew continues with weekly cemetery and grounds maintenance, as well as boat ramp and beach clean-up. The Public Safety Building roof project is tentatively scheduled to begin the week of September 4<sup>th</sup>.

**Fleet:** Staff worked on Car 223 change/rewire headlight/strobes; Eq16 road call-limp mode/diagnose def system; Trk8 PM service; Eq14 def/head unit issue; Trk5 PTO issue; Trk9 replace tires; Car171 tire leak.

**Highway:** The highway crew continues with grading, shoulder, and ditch work along several roads. Also did some tree work. Road work last week included Sibley, Ossipee Park Rd, Ferry Rd, Smith Rd, Blake Rd. Burial at Shannon cemetery.

**Transfer Station:** This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste (36 tons), 4 containers of single stream recycling (20 tons), and 9 containers of construction and demolition (45 tons). The brush pile was burned, and the compost pile turned.

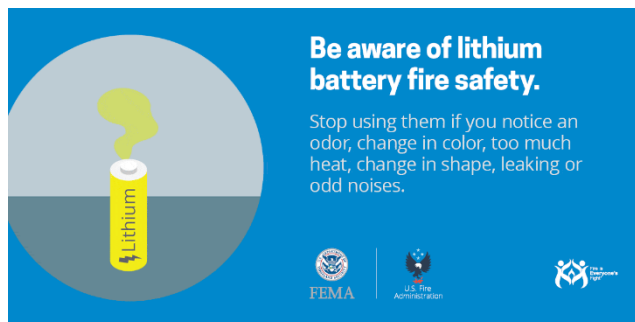
