The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Administration and Finance

We also processed wetlands applications, voter registrations/party changes, assisted new residents with establishing residency, continued preparing for the Presidential Primary, and assisted the Supervisors of the Checklist with NCOA procedures, among other services.

2024 Presidential Primary Information

The last day for voters to change party affiliation prior to the Presidential Primary is Friday, October 6th. When voting in any Primary election, voters who have a party declared (Democrat or Republican) can only receive the ballot for their declared party. Voters who are “Undeclared,” may choose either ballot. Moultonborough voters can check their party affiliation [online through the Secretary of State’s website](#), on the Voter Checklist in the lobby of Town Hall, or by contacting the Town Clerk’s office.

If you would like to change your party affiliation, you may do so in the Town Clerk’s office Monday – Friday between 7:30 am and 4 pm or with the Supervisors of the Checklist between 7 pm and 7:30 pm on Friday, October 6th at Town Hall. Please bring a government-issued photo ID in either case.

Since the date of the Primary has not yet been announced, we are not able to accept absentee ballot applications at this time. If a date still has not been announced by November 10th (14 days after the filing period for candidates has closed), voters who believe they will not be able to vote in person on election day will then be able to submit an absentee ballot request to the Town Clerk. The Moultonborough Town Hall will be closed on Friday, November 10th in observance of the Veteran's Day holiday so the first day voters will be able to file their request in person with the Moultonborough Town Clerk's office will be Monday, November 13th.

Please keep an eye on the website for future election information as it becomes available.

The Town Clerk's office will be **CLOSED Thursday, October 12th so staff can attend a statewide Municipal Clerk training.**

Department of Public Works
