The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: Storm clean up. Replaced the batteries in alarm panel. Met with air vent representative. Hung tv for the Fire Department. Winter maintenance. Generator exercise. Cleaned out storage space. Lions Club doorknob. Put up wreaths in the town hall parking lot. Repaired flagpole rope.

Fleet: Plowed East side. Checked trk24 for hydraulic leak. Trk11 taillight. Worked on pusher. Cleaned up the shop. Returned tool to Wolfeboro. Checked out car 182. Tires on Trk4 and heater motor. Front tires on Eq12. Paperwork.

Highway: Town wide storm. Salted black ice from re-freezing. Worked on Trk1 plow and sander. Calibrated Trk5 sander. Checked private roads. Tree job on Sawmill. Chipped brush. Cleaned up the shop. Cleaned and sharpened chainsaws. Dump run.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste = 24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle = 10 tons, 4 containers of construction and demolition = 20 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal. Compost pile turned and the brush pile was burned, 69 propane tanks were picked up to be recycled. Vehicle counts: Monday 160, Tuesday 335, Friday 350, Saturday 300, Sunday 301 total 1446 vehicles.

Operations: 12/05 The Chief performed an inspection of a potential rental property on Suissevale Ave for Life Safety Code compliance. Firefighters Bassett, Beede, Brown, and Houghton joined the Chief in attending a presentation by Deputy Chief David Hall of the Franklin Fire Department on Lithium-Ion battery fires. The class was attended by fifty firefighters from across the state and featured Hooksett Fire Chief Steve Colburn who spoke about how his department extinguished and mitigated an EV SUV fire in their community. 12/07 The fire chief and firefighters Cavic and Manville performed the annual school inspection at Moultonborough Academy and Central School. 12/08 Chief Bengtson and the C-Group firefighters inspected a wood stove for a Bodge Hill Road resident looking to obtain a letter of compliance for their insurance company.

Burning Permits: The fire danger level remains at “Low.” Residents and property owners are still required to obtain fire permits for all open burning, including campfires, and brush burning until snow covers the ground. Fire Permits may be obtained at the Public Safety Building located at 1035 Whittier Highway or online at www.NHFirePermit.com. Or a <https://nh.burnsafeamerica.com/>.

Fire permits are not required when there is snow covering the ground. If snow cover is not present, a fire permit is required.
