The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: Worked on Budget with Chris. Addressing a leaky valve. Set up the side boards for Trk24. Replaced water valve on apparatus bay. Replaced zone valve for Town Clerks office. Reset water pressure. Stained side boards. Dropped lift off at the academy. Picked up new valves for heat. Filled drain holes at the rink and blew out before the rain. Building checks. Trash and cardboard pick up. Fence repair.

Fleet: Paperwork. Trk19 brakes. Trk 1 wipers. Went to Viking to pick up Trk2 and get Trk5 repaired under warranty. Trk5 performed PM-B service. Set up belt on shoulder machine. Set up of new Trk2. Facility audit. Trk5 make bracket for sander control. Inventory. Closed out work orders.

Highway: The highway crew checked roads from the heavy rain. Filled potholes and graded. Looked at dead trees to cut. Checked beaver pipes. Marked trees for cutting. Went over budget with Chris. Painted Trk2 wheels. Salted roads from snow squalls. Cutting edge on Trk2. Calibrated sander. Shoulder work on Krainewood.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste = 24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle = 10 tons, 6 containers of construction and demolition = 30 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal. 52 Freon containing units were recycled, compost pile turned, and brush pile burned. Car counts: Monday 285, Tuesday 300, Friday 340, Saturday 310, Sunday 200 total vehicles 1435.

Fire permits are not required when there is snow covering the ground. If snow cover is not present, a fire permit is required.
