The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The crew continues with Ice Rink maintenance. Building checks. Flushed drains at PSB. Continued cemetery fence repair. Recyclables and trash throughout all buildings. Built bracket for new wreaths. Cleaned old fire station. Town Hall, PSB and PD air vents. Marked out Holland Hill Cemetery lot.

Fleet: Fixed lights on Trk5 and Trk2 spreaders. Car171 heat problems. Loaded wood chips. Changed brushes on wet broom. Cleaned up and reorganized the garage.

Highway: The Highway crew continues to check roads. Shoulder work on Long Point Road. Ditching on Kona and Shaker Jerry. Worked on Trk2 Sander. Checked catch basins and drainage. Fabricated new shoot for shoulder machine.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste = 36 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle = 10 tons and 5 containers of construction and demolition = 25 tons. The compost pile was turned, and brush pile burned. Car counts: Monday closed Christmas, Tuesday 602, Friday 650, Saturday 510, Sunday 232 total vehicles 1994.

Operations: 12/27 Rescue 2 was taken to Irwin's for a dealer warrantied repair. At the Town Meeting in June, Article 4 approved by the voters directed the Selectmen to hire, train, properly equip and maintain six fulltime firefighter/EMS providers adding to the two existing firefighters to be on duty 24/7/365. On October 30, 2023, the fire department began 24-hour staffing with four groups of two firefighters working 24-hour shifts. 2023 marks the third consecutive year that the fire department has responded to more than one thousand incidents.

Burning Permits: As we enter the new year, all persons wishing to kindle fires will need new 2024 fire permits.

The fire danger level remains at "Low." Residents and property owners are still required to obtain fire permits for all open burning, including campfires, and brush burning until snow covers the ground. Fire Permits may be obtained at the Public Safety Building located at 1035 Whittier Highway or online at www.NHFirePermit.com. Or a <https://nh.burnsafeamerica.com/>

Fire permits are not required when there is snow covering the ground. If snow cover is not present, a fire permit is required.
