The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: Dug cremation burial in Holland Hill Cemetery. Installed new domestic hot water circulator. The crew continues with Ice Rink maintenance. Removed holiday wreaths from the Village. CJIS training. Met with electrician for LED lights at PSB and met with generator tech at the Transfer Station. Set up plows for the storm. Brought wire to scrap yard. All building checks for trash and recyclables, cardboard collected. Drains flushed at PSB.

Fleet: Cleaned and rebuilt racks in the Parts Room. New lights and wires have been put on Trk1 plow. Nox sen and mod on Trk11. Brought steel to Transfer Station. Prepared trucks for the storm.

Highway: The highway crew continues with tree cutting and chipping on Ossipee Park Road, Randall, and Severance. Salted ice spots from running water. Marked trees. The crew prepped for the storm. Checked plow routes. Plowed and treated roads. Completed paperwork.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste=24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle=10 tons and 7 containers of construction and demolition=35 tons. The brush pile was burned, and compost pile was turned. Car counts: Monday closed New Years, Tuesday 515, Friday 402, Saturday 502, Sunday 26 (very low vehicle count due to the snow event) total 1445 vehicles.

Operations: 1/2/2024 Chief Bengtson attended the LRMFA Executive Committee meeting at the Communication Center in Laconia. 1/3/2024 Moultonborough provided coverage to the Town of Center Harbor while their personnel covered the Meredith Fire Department during the calling hours for Captain Taggett. 1/4/2024 Moultonborough provided coverage to the Town of Center Harbor while their personnel covered the Meredith Fire Department during the funeral for Captain Taggett.

The Department has made operational changes to its ice rescue responses. The inflatable ice rescue boat will now be kept, fully inflated on Rescue 1. This change, combined with the department now having full-time staffing, will allow for rapid deployment of personnel onto the ice or into the water to affect a rescue.

Burning Permits: Resident and property owners are reminded that all persons wishing to kindle fires will need new 2024 fire permits.

The fire danger level remains at “Low.” Residents and property owners are still required to obtain fire permits for all open burning, including campfires, and brush burning until snow covers the ground. Fire permits are not required when there is snow covering the ground. If snow cover is not present, a fire permit is required.
