The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The crew continues with Ice Rink maintenance, addressed the septic issue at the Lions Club and ordered new toilets. Cleaned and greased sanders. Building checks throughout town.

Fleet: The mechanics addressed a tire issue at the Transfer Station and brought up welding equipment. Facility audit was completed. Waste oil was pumped. Trk6 adjust brakes and freed up adjustors. Car171. Rinse Trk3 & 8. Work orders for Eq12. Checked for leaks. Car151 belt issue. Trk9 Reset system after VGT replacement. Eq47 broom, Trk2 calibrate sander and controls.

Highway: The highway crew salted icy areas, sanded dirt roads and checked private roads. Tree work continues. Potholes patched and road checks throughout town.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 1 container of municipal solid waste = 12 tons, 1 container of single stream recycle = 5 tons, 5 containers of construction and demolition = 30 tons. The compost pile was turned, brush pile burned, scrap metal loaded into its container, 24 propane tanks were collected by vendor to be recycled. Car counts: Monday 255, Tuesday 300, Friday 310, Saturday 280, Sunday 200 total 1345 vehicles served.

Engine 1 and Rescue 2 went to Lakes Region Fire Apparatus for routine fire pump repairs. 2/10/2024 The fire department assisted the police department, transporting officers to Little Gansy Island in the hovercraft for an investigation.

Burning Permits: All persons wishing to kindle fires will need new 2024 fire permits. Fire Permits may be obtained at the Public Safety Building located at 1035 Whittier Highway or online at www.NHFirePermit.com. Or a <https://nh.burnsafeamerica.com/>.

Fire permits are not required when there is snow covering the ground. If snow cover is not present, a fire permit is required.

Moultonborough Firefighters in action: February 5th at 11:51pm firefighters were dispatch to an outside fire with exposure to a building. Upon arrival, firefighters found a burn barrel and building construction materials burning approximately 15-feet from a home under construction. The fire was extinguished. The burning of building construction material and demolition are prohibited by NH DES regulations.
