Town Administrator: This past week's activities included continued research and work on documents for transfer of Town property at 4 Whittier Highway, directed the monthly Department Head meeting, prepared for and attended the Select Board's weekly meeting, and the proposed FY 17 operating and capital budget and Town Meeting Warrant hearing, attended the Planning Board's Master Plan update hearing, met with Superintendent Noyes and met with Primex CEO Ty Gagne. This week I will continue work on revisions to the employee evaluation form and process, place ads for the Town Assessor and floater and DPW clerk positions, submit budget and warrant to DRA for pre-review, attend the Milfoil Committee meeting and the monthly NH Municipal Managers meeting and training, and prepare for the Select Board's meeting on Thursday at 7 p.m. Have a great week!

Finance: Nothing to report this week.

Assessor: Vision Government Solutions is continuing the cyclical measure and list for 2017. They will be continuing inspections in the eastern end of Town and will also be starting the review process for all sales and building permits that have occurred since April 1, 2016. All Vision personnel drive a marked vehicle, carry an introductory letter from the Town and always have a photo ID.

Public Works & Facilities: Last week Highway crews continued to perform routine winter fleet maintenance both prior to and after the storm event. With more salt and sand deliveries, the crews continued to make the "magic mix" and also restock the sand/salt shed.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped 1 msw and 1 demo. Staff kept the facility clear of snow and safe for the residents.

Moultonborough Police Department: The Police Department recorded 301 log entries, which included the following calls for service, 7 motor vehicle stops, 10 assists to Fire/EMS, 0 Directed Patrols, 3 arrests, 3 complaints, 4 MV Accidents, 1 MV Complaint, 5 residential alarms, 2 commercial alarms and 3 K-9 complaints.
