The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The crew continues with building & cemetery checks, recyclables and trash collected. The bike path was cleaned. PSB leak & faucet repair. Got everything together for the school board meeting. Leaf cleanup and Snow Removal.

Fleet: Eq23 & Trk10 prepared for license test. Trk20 reported running issue, reset system. 15-C-1 exhaust repair. Trk8 was brought to Crest Auto World for recalls. Trk10 was evaluated for check engine light, pulled front temp sensor clean and regen road test truck. Repaired auger on Trk6, Trk10 set up sander chain. Car 211 disabled battery.

Highway: The highway crew continues to check roads from heavy rain. The crew raked roads and fixed transitions with a backhoe. Plowed and treated roads during the weekend storm.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 1 container of municipal solid waste = 12 Tons, 1 container of single stream recycling = 2 Tons and 3 containers of construction and demolition = 18 Tons. On Saturday, March 9, 2024, at 2:33 p.m., a Moultonborough Police Officer was involved in a single vehicle crash on Whittier Highway (Route 25) at the intersection of Sheridan Road. Officer Andrew Strickland was travelling eastbound on Whittier Highway (Route 25), when his cruiser left the south-erly side of the roadway, went down an embankment, across a brook, striking another embankment on the opposite side and rolling over onto the passenger's side. The officer was initially trapped in-side the cruiser, but numerous witnesses came to the officer's aid and assisted him out of the cruiser. Additional officers from the Moultonborough Police Department, Center Harbor Police Department, Sandwich Police Department, Carroll County Sheriff's Office, and New Hampshire State Police Troop E responded, as well as Moultonborough Fire-Rescue Department and Stewart's Ambulance. The officer sustained minor injuries and was transported by Stewart's Ambulance to Concord Hospi-tal-Laconia, where he was treated and released. New Hampshire State Police Troop E is investigating the cause of the crash. The Moultonborough Police Department is grateful to the citizens who came to the officer's aid.
