Department of Public Works

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste=24 tons, 1 container of single stream recycle=5 tons, 11 containers of construction and demolition=66 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal. The Moultonborough Kindergarten class got a tour of the Transfer Station this past week. 41 students learned the basics as to how our facility operates; they had many great questions. A big thank you to all the volunteers and staff that made the tour great, it couldn't have been done without you. The brush pile was burned, and the compost pile turned.
