The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Administration and Finance

Town Clerk: In the month of May 2024, the Town Clerk's office processed:

We also processed wetlands applications, voter registrations/party changes, absentee ballot applications, assisted new residents with establishing residency, and facilitated the May Town & School election/Town Meeting, among other services.

All dogs licensed between January 1st and April 30th will be automatically entered into the Top Dog Contest. We will randomly select a tag number each month throughout the year to be named Dog of the Month. The Dog of the Month wins bragging rights and their portrait will be hung in the Town Clerk’s office for that month. In February of the following year, all the winners of the Dog of the Month drawing from the prior year will be eligible candidates for the Dog of the Year Election.

Dog Licenses: Late fees have been applied to all dog licenses that were not renewed by May 31st. The Town Clerk’s office has been reaching out to all owners whose dogs have not been updated in our system through phone calls, emails, and through the mail. All dog owners are required by NH State law to register their dogs with their Town Clerk annually by April 30th. Per RSA 466:14, the Town Clerk is required to report all unlicensed dogs to the Select Board by June 20th. Late fees began June 1st, at \$1.00/month per dog. Civil forfeiture fines will be issued and delivered by the police in July, at \$25.00/late dog, in addition to the monthly late fees. Pay NOW to avoid further late fees!

We can accept checks made out to *Town of Moultonborough*, cash, or credit cards if paying in person or online. There is a 3% processing fee added by your credit card company for all card transactions.

Boat Registrations: 2024 boat stickers are available! To renew your boat registration with the Town Clerk’s office, bring your renewal notice from the State (signed by the primary owner), last year’s signed registration, or a completed [Boat Application](#). *Please note:* there is an additional \$5.00 per boat Agent Fee for transactions processed through any town or marina – if you received a renewal notice from the State, simply add \$5.00 to the total listed for each boat you wish to register with the Town. When you register your boats locally, more of that revenue stays with the town than if you were to send payment directly to the state.

The Deadline to Change Party Affiliation Before the September 10th State Primary is Tuesday, June 4th

If you wish to change your party affiliation, please bring your government-issued photo ID with you to the Town Clerk’s office during normal business hours by the deadline, or to the Supervisors of the Checklist’s meeting from 7:00 – 7:30pm here at Town Hall on June 4th.

Operations: 5/27/2024 Firefighter Beede and Chief Bengtson joined Sergeant Balser and Officer Cloutier in providing the color guard for the Memorial Day parade. 5/30/2024 The Department held its first badge pinning ceremony for the six new fulltime firefighters and the promotions of Call personnel to Deputy Chief and Lieutenant positions. Firefighters Jack Cavic, Tyler Driscoll, Logan Eldridge, Jaan Luikmil, and Tim Moar were sworn in by Town Clerk Julia Marchand and had their badges pinned by their family members. Tim Gatherum was sworn in as a Call lieutenant and David Houghton as a Call Deputy Chief. The ceremony was intended to recognize the hard work of the new personnel in their probationary period and celebrate with their families their

transition into the fire department as valued members of our family. The ceremony featured comments guest speaker Selectman Jon Tolman who was instrumental in helping the fire department get increased staffing.

Burning Permits: Fire danger conditions are improving as things green-up, but residents should remain cautious as wind and dry leaves and grass can easily aid in rapid fire spread. Many residents have expressed problems obtaining fire permits using the on-line system. The on-line system is owned and operated by the State. Problems with the on-line system should be addressed through the customer service number provided. If unable to obtain a fire permit on-line, residents may obtain fire permits at the Public Safety Building. Permits will be issued when personnel are in the building, as we are an emergency service, sometimes we are not in the building, please be patient and try again later if no one is available to assist you.

Fire Permits are now required for all open burning. Fire Permits may be obtained at the Public Safety Building located at 1035 Whittier Highway or online at www.NHFirePermit.com. Or a <https://nh.burnsafeamerica.com/>

Rental property owners are reminded that fire permits are issued to the person, not the property. Renters will need written permission of the property owner to kindle fires on the property being rented. The renter will need to obtain a fire permit for the period in which they are renting the property.
