The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The facilities crew built a deck around the generator at the Academy for service and met with the generator company at the library. A cable was repaired at the Fire Station. Meeting with Christina and town officials. Beaches were raked, pickle ball courts were cleaned. A burial at Shannon Cemetery was marked. Mowing, trimming, trash, and collection of recyclables.

Fleet: Truck 24 brake issue was addressed, oil changed, and filters pulled, seal set up for inspection. The fuel filter was pulled and worked on preventative maintenance. Truck 9 engine light. Equipment 13 was having electrical issues. Invoices completed. The chip trailer was loaded. Motor oil barrels were swapped.

Operations: 8/30 Moultonborough firefighters were requested to assist with a carry out of an injured hiker on the Pasture trail in Holderness. The Duty crew was out of town for an hour and 15 minutes for this assignment. The station was covered by Call personnel and the chief.

Burning Permits: Fire danger conditions are improving as things green-up, but residents should remain cautious as wind and dry leaves and grass can easily aid in rapid fire spread. The Daily Fire Danger notifications can be obtained at <https://www.nhdfl.dnrcr.nh.gov/forest-protection/daily-fire-danger>.

Many residents have expressed problems obtaining fire permits using the on-line system. The on-line system is owned and operated by the State. Problems with the on-line system should be addressed through the customer service number provided. If unable to obtain a fire permit on-line, residents may obtain fire permits at the Public Safety Building. Permits will be issued when personnel are in the building, as we are an emergency service, sometimes we are not in the building, please be patient and try again later if no one is available to assist you.

Fire Permits are now required for all open burning. Fire Permits may be obtained at the Public Safety Building located at 1035 Whittier Highway or online at www.NHFirePermit.com. Or a <https://nh.burnsafeamerica.com/>.

Rental property owners are reminded that fire permits are issued to the person, not the property. Renters will need written permission of the property owner to kindle fires on the property being rented. The renter will need to obtain a fire permit for the period in which they are renting the property.

Fireworks:

- You must be 12 years of age to buy and possess fireworks.
- Fireworks may only be used on private property that you own, or with written permission from the landowner, or in the presence of the landowner. If you are renting property, you must have written permission from the landowner to display fireworks.
- The use and display of fireworks on Town property, beaches, and docks is prohibited.

Moultonborough Ordinance # 22 limits the use of fireworks to the hours between 12 noon and 10:00pm. Exceptions are two holidays, as recognized by the Town: (1) the 4th of July:

limit use to 12 noon to 12 midnight; (2) New Year, limit use to 12 noon and up to 15 minutes past midnight the holiday.
