Administration & Finance

Weekly Update: The first CIPC meeting is scheduled for next Thursday, September 18, 2025. Throughout this week, the Finance Director has been meeting with departments to review payroll wages, benefits, and position titles as part of Phase I of the FY27 budget process. On Friday, I'll be sending out the budget guidance memo, budget sheets, and a timeline outlining key dates and deadlines to all department managers. I've also been working with the Human Resources Director on several personnel items and will be moving forward with DPW and Police contract negotiations later this month. In the meantime, I continue to respond to calls, attend meetings, and manage both immediate priorities and long-term planning. Thank you all for your ongoing support and collaboration as I continue to settle into the role and we move into budget season. It truly takes a team, and I appreciate everyone's efforts!
