The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Administration & Finance

Weekly Update: A budget work session with the Board of Selectmen and the Advisory Budget Committee is scheduled for Friday, October 24, 2025. The session will begin with a comprehensive review involving department managers, who will present and discuss their proposed budgets and priorities for the upcoming fiscal year. They will also be available to answer questions and engage in discussion with the Board and Committee members. This collaborative session aims to ensure transparency, alignment of goals, and informed decision-making as the town prepares its FY27 budget.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The facilities and grounds crew fixed 2 toilets at the Town Hall. Holland Hill Cemetery cremation burial. A water sample was brought to Concord. Weekly building checks, trash, and recycling picked up and disposed of. Water was delivered to the Recreation Department. Leaf cleanup at Middle Neck Cemetery. Long Island and States Landing beaches were cleaned up. At Ames Cemetery trees were cut and brush picked up.

Plow frames were prepped for winter. Redding Lane, Ben Berry and Randell Road were watered down, and Randell Road was rolled. Old Red Hill, Sibley, and Wakonda Road were blown off.
