The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The facilities and grounds crew plowed and treated the town facilities and roads. The ice rink was maintained. Recyclables were collected. Water was delivered to town buildings.

Fleet: The mechanics repaired sanders. Trucks were loaded with material to treat roads for the storm. Truck 19 starter issue was addressed. Truck 15 hydraulic pump issue was repaired. Truck 3 system was reset. Snow tires were put on to truck 5. Sander and hoses were set up. The shop was cleaned. Private contractor's sander issue was repaired. Equipment 12 clean up snow piles. Two new tires were mounted and balanced on truck 20.

Highway: The highway crew plowed and treated the roads throughout town after the snowstorm. The sand bin was filled, truck 24 maintained. Truck 7 was set up. Trucks and sanders were washed. Chains tightened and greased. Tires were put on to truck 20. Ladders were fabricated for sanders.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste = 36 tons, 2 containers of singles stream recycle = 10 tons and 1 container of construction and demolition = 5 tons. Vehicle counts: Monday 91, Tuesday 425, Friday CLOSED NEW YEARS, Saturday 853, Sunday 327 total vehicle counts 1696 = 62 per hour.

Operations:

12/29 An ice storm brought a flurry of incidents for the fire department with personnel responding to 29 incidents, including outside fires, EMS incidents, motor vehicle accidents, carbon monoxide incidents, service calls and trees on wires. One incident resulted in the closure of Moultonboro Neck Road for several hours.

The fire department ended 2025 by responding to 1,090 incidents.

Burning Permits:

Per Administrative Rule Res 5601.02, A fire permit shall be required for all open burning when the ground is not covered by snow. *“Ground covered with snow”* means the area within a 100-foot radius from the fire edge is covered with snow or other frozen precipitation sufficient to prevent the combustion of woodland fuels until the fire is completely extinguished. As there is now snow cover in place, no fire permit is required for permissible open burning.
