Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The facilities and grounds crew plowed and treated roads and town buildings. The meeting room was set up for the Public Hearing. The ice rink was flooded and maintained. Trash and recyclables were collected and disposed of. The door at the Neck Fire Station was repaired. Truck 4 was washed and sander removed. Water was picked up at the Castle. Batteries, wire, and copper were collected from the Transfer Station and brought to Bristol.

Fleet: The mechanics repaired equipment 14's quick connect pistons and oil leak in equipment 39. Truck 1 sander was wired. Car 171 had preventative maintenance done. Differential in 15-R-3 was repaired. Truck 11 sander issue was repaired along with the light problem. Truck 6 overheating issue was diagnosed. Cars 181, 171 and 161 were repaired. The hydraulic hose was replaced on equipment 14. Truck 15 sander chains tightened. The roller was moved to the shop.

Highway: The highway crew plowed and treated roads town wide after the winter weather events and snow drifts. Roads were checked throughout the week and treated as needed. Sand/salt was mixed and pushed up in the shed. The wood chip trailer was loaded. Waste oil was pumped. Truck 9 wing cutting edge was switched. Plow frame was welded on truck 15. The loader and trucks were cleaned!
