The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Administration & Finance

Weekly Update: Last week, the Board of Selectmen held its regular meeting on January 20, 2026, followed by the second public hearing on January 23, 2026, regarding the potential acquisition of 81 Whittier Highway. These meetings provided residents with an opportunity to offer feedback on the proposed purchase. If approved at the 2026 Town Meeting, the acquisition would be funded using unassigned fund balance and existing capital reserve funds and would have no impact on the tax rate.

I would like to extend my appreciation to the Board of Selectmen, department managers, and staff who worked diligently to compile detailed information and prepare a clear, factual presentation for the community. Your attention to detail and commitment to transparency helped ensure residents received accurate information and meaningful opportunities to participate.

We also sincerely thank the residents who attended, asked questions, and provided input. Both public hearings were conducted respectfully, and your thoughtful engagement is greatly appreciated. The presentation is available on the Town's website and may also be viewed via the Town Hall streams for those who were unable to attend or who wish to learn more.

As we continue through budget season, please note that a public hearing is scheduled for Tuesday, February 3, 2026, at 5:00 PM at Town Hall to review proposed warrant and budget items and receive public input.

Finance: This week I completed payroll, worked on payroll accruals, researched and supplied auditors with requested information. Worked on annual reports and account reconciliations for all escrow accounts.

Code, Compliance & Health Office: Nothing reported.

Department of Public Works

Facilities/Grounds: The facilities and grounds crew plowed and treated town buildings after the winter storm. Trash and recyclables were collected. The ice rink was cleared and maintained. A meeting at Cru Con was held. Snowbanks were pushed back.

Fleet: The mechanics plowed and treated roads townwide after the winter weather. Truck 4 system was reset after preventative maintenance and def line assembly replacement. Truck 6 fan cluck was repaired. Truck 2 plow and sander leak were addressed. Spinner was replaced on truck 1. Truck 5 solenoid was fixed. Replaced passenger side front door latch in car 171. Small issues were fixed with plows after the week of winter plowing operations.

Highway: This past week the highway crew cleaned snow drifts and sanded roads town wide. Sanders and trucks were washed. Roads were plowed after the winter weather. Waste oil was pumped. Truck 1 sander was repaired, and plow edge was put on truck 24. Sand was pushed up and mixed. The sander on truck 3 was repaired. Ladder on truck 24, welded sander on truck 9. A dump run from the shop was made to the Transfer Station. Trees were checked and cut.
