The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Administration & Finance

Assessor: This week, we welcome, Tracy Cragin, as the town's new Assessing Technician. Tracy will be working full-time in the assessing office, assisting taxpayers, with their credit, exemption, and abatement applications, as well as assisting with the maintenance of our property records.

Department of Public Works

Highway: The Highway team continued working on road maintenance activities including grading, ditching, and culvert work on Glidden Rd along with tree trimming the Winaukee Rd area.

Transfer station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste = 24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle = 10 tons and 6 containers of construction and demolition = 30 tons. Compost pile was turned, brush was piled, and Facility and Grounds transported to the local recycling facility 2524 pounds of wet cell batteries and 800 pounds of wire. Car counts Monday 345, Tuesday 391, Friday 506, Saturday 333, Sunday 251 total 1826 residents served.

Operations: Chief Bengtson watched video of the Town training on harassment presented by attorney Mark Broth on September 22, 2021. Officer's meeting with Call company officers. The fire chief participated in the TRC meeting reviewing a 30-unit housing proposal on Bean Road. The fire chief met with the Town Administrator and DPW Director to investigate the on the ground condition, to consider a fire department water supply site on Kona Farm Road.

Burning Permits: 2021 Fire permits are available at the Public Safety Building and on-line at www.NHFirepermit.com. The fee for an online fire permit is \$5.50. The Town of Moultonborough does not control, run, or manage the online permit system. Property owners with rental properties are reminded that "written permission" must be given to anyone renting the property to kindle a fire on the property being rented. The letter of permission must indicate the category of fire allowed and the duration in which the renter is allowed to kindle the fire.
