The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Highway: Last week the Highway Team tended to the roads for winter maintenance to keep the roadways safe for travel during the holidays including the Christmas Day storm.

Transfer station: This week we shipped out 1 container of municipal solid waste = 12 tons, 1 container of single stream recycle = 5 tons, 2 containers of construction and demolition = 10 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal.

Car counts Monday 228, Tuesday 446, Friday 378, Saturday Christmas closed, Sunday 138 total of 1190 residents served.

Facilities & Grounds: The past week the Facilities & Grounds crew started flooding the rink for the winter season, we stayed busy with winter maintenance at the facilities parking lots and sidewalks.

Public Safety

Moultonborough Police Department: The Moultonborough Police Department recorded 189 log entries, which included the following calls for service, 8 Assist Citizens, 19 Motor Vehicle Stops, 11 Assists to Fire/EMS, 0 Directed Patrols, 0 Arrest, 0 complaints, 5 MV Accidents, 4 MV Complaints, 7 Residential Alarms, 0 Commercial Alarms, and 4 K-9 complaints.
