The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

### Administration and Finance

**Assessing:** Exemption and credit qualification verification letters, were sent out, to recipients. The purpose of these letters is to ensure that the recipients qualifications status has not changed, and our records are accurate and in compliance with State laws and rules. It is important for recipients to return their responses to these letters, so that they do not disrupt or lose their exemptions/credits. We also continue to work on reviewing all new construction and building permits, in preparation for the 2022 tax year permit inspections.

Whitney Consulting Group (WCG) continues to work on completing cyclical inspections. Their field staff will be working throughout town. All their field staff will have a photo identification badge and an introduction letter, on town letterhead, from the Town Assessor.

### Department of Public Works

### **Public Safety**

**Moultonborough Police Department:** The Moultonborough Police Department recorded 260 log entries, which included the following calls for service, 4 Assist Citizens, 20 Motor Vehicle Stops, 10 Assists to Fire/EMS, 0 Directed Patrols, 3 Arrest, 5 complaints, 6 MV Accidents, 5 MV Complaints, 4 Residential Alarms, 3 Commercial Alarms, and 0 K-9 complaints.

**Moultonborough Fire Rescue:** For the period of 02/11/2022 to 02/17/2022, there were nine calls for service: There was: 6 EMS incidents, 1 Carbon monoxide incident, 1 Alarm system sounded due to malfunction, 1 Alarm system activation, no fire, unintentional.

**Total 2022 Incidents: 91 Down 27% from 2021 Automatic Aid:** Once from Center Harbor and once from Stewart's Ambulance Mutual Aid: None

**Overlapping Incidents: Two Year to Date: 10 Percentage of Call Volume: 11%.** Overlapping incidents are where two or more incidents are occurring simultaneously.

**Operations:** 2/11-Chief Bengtson presented the department budget to the Select Board and Advisory Budget Committee. 2/14-Chief Bengtson provided a life safety code consultation for a Moultonboro Neck Road business. 2/15-Chief Bengtson participated in a TRC review of a traffic study for a Bean Road development. 2/17-The department EMS personnel participated in monthly continuing education on behavioral emergencies. Paramedic John Burdette presented the training.

**Burning Permits:** As we enter days of increasing daylight and stronger sunlight, there will be areas lacking sufficient snow cover to burn without a fire permit. Permits are not required when there is sufficient snow cover on the ground to prevent the spread of fire to the woodlands. Snow cover must reach 100-feet in every direction around the burn pile.

2022 Fire permits are available at the Public Safety Building and on-line at [www.NHFirepermit.com](http://www.NHFirepermit.com). The fee for an online fire permit is \$5.50. The Town of Moultonborough does not control, run, or manage the online permit system. Property owners with rental properties are reminded that "written permission" must be given to anyone renting the property to kindle a fire on the property being rented. The letter of permission must indicate the category of fire allowed and the duration in which the renter is permitted to kindle the fire.

RSA 125-N:4 Prohibits the open burning of combustible domestic waste. "Combustible domestic waste" means combustible waste such as, but not limited to, household trash, packaging materials, plastics, coated or laminated papers, rubber, painted, or treated wood, coated, or treated cardboard, oily rags, and animal, vegetable, and kitchen waste.
