The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Administration and Finance

Assessing: Our office has sent out 2nd notices for verification requests that were sent to recipients of property exemptions and credits. The intent of the verification request letters is to ensure that recipients qualification status have not changed and that our records are accurate and in compliance with State laws and rules. *It is important for recipients to return their responses to these letters, so that they do not disrupt or lose their exemptions/credits.* We also continue to work on compiling all new construction and building permits, in preparation for the 2022 tax year permit inspections.

Our tax mapping contractor has completed preliminary updates of the tax maps, for the land use changes that occurred during the 2021 tax year. We have reviewed these map updates and will continue to make updates for any new changes, up until the start of the new tax year, April 1, 2022. Whitney Consulting Group (WCG) continues to work on completing cyclical inspections. Their field staff will be working throughout town. All their field staff will have a photo identification badge and an introduction letter, on town letterhead, from the Town Assessor.

Department of Public Works

Transfer station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste = 24 tons, 1 container of single stream recycle = 5 tons and 4 containers of construction and demolition = 20 tons. The brush pile was burned, and the recycled electronics container was shipped.

EQ14 2015 CAT 926M loader replaced bucket lock hydraulic hoses. Parts run to Sandown and Concord for EQ40 and EQ56.

Moultonborough Police Department: The Moultonborough Police Department recorded 193 log entries, which included the following calls for service, 7 Assist Citizens, 26 Motor Vehicle Stops, 6 Assists to Fire/EMS, 0 Directed Patrols, 0 Arrest, 3 complaints, 0 MV Accidents, 3 MV Complaints, 3 Residential Alarms, 3 Commercial Alarms, and 0 K-9 complaints.

Overlapping incidents are where two or more incidents are occurring simultaneously.

Operations: 3/21, Department personnel trained at the Transfer Station on fire attack hose line deployment. 8 members attended the drill.

Burning Permits: Fire permits are now required for all open burning. 2022 Fire permits are available at the Public Safety Building and on-line at www.NHFirepermit.com. The fee for an online fire permit is \$5.50. The Town of Moultonborough does not control, run, or manage the

online permit system. Property owners with rental properties are reminded that "written permission" must be given to anyone renting the property to kindle a fire on the property being rented. The letter of permission must indicate the category of fire allowed and the duration in which the renter is permitted to kindle the fire.

RSA 125-N:4 Prohibits the open burning of combustible domestic waste. "Combustible domestic waste" means combustible waste such as, but not limited to, household trash, packaging materials, plastics, coated or laminated papers, rubber, painted, or treated wood, coated, or treated cardboard, oily rags, and animal, vegetable, and kitchen waste.
