The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Transfer station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste = 24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle = 10 tons, 6 containers of construction and demolition = 30 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal. The brush pile was burned, and compost pile was turned.

Car counts Monday closed for training, Tuesday 787, Friday 490, Saturday 367, Sunday 375 total of 2019 residents served.

Facilities and Grounds: The past week the Facilities & Grounds crew have been out mowing and trimming cemeteries and other town properties. We have started our weekly beach maintenance as we prepare for the upcoming season! The painting contractor should be wrapping up at the end of the week at the Public Safety Building.
