The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Facilities and Grounds: The past week the F&G crew mowed and trimmed town properties and cemeteries and assisted with a burial. The painting contractor should be finishing up the apparatus bay this week.

The lions club freezers were delivered and put in place, and we are finishing up that project in the next few weeks.

Transfer station: This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste=36 tons, 3 containers of single stream recycle = 15 tons and 8 containers of construction and demolition = 40 tons. Compost pile was turned, and the brush pile was burned. Car counts Monday: closed Memorial Day, Tuesday: 825, Friday: 570, Saturday: 447, Sunday: 285 total 2127 residents served.
