The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

### Department of Public Works

**Transfer Station:** This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste = 36 tons, 3 containers of single stream recycle = 15 tons, 5 containers of construction and demolition = 25 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal. Compost pile was turned, and the very large quantity of brush was burned.

Car counts Monday 505, Tuesday 604, Friday 800, Saturday 545, Sunday 280 total of 2737 residents served.

### Public Safety

**Moultonborough Police Department:** The Moultonborough Police Department recorded 275 log entries, which included the following calls for service; 4 Assist Citizens, 7 Motor Vehicle Stops, 13 Assists to Fire/EMS, 4 Directed Patrols, 0 Arrest, 7 complaints, 4 MV Accidents, 7 MV Complaints, 7 Residential Alarms, 1 Commercial Alarms, and 3 K-9 complaints.

Gentle Yoga is offered on Mondays @ 5:30 pm & Wednesdays @ 8:15am. Gentle Yoga is an all-levels class to focus on mindful movement with breath & a slow relaxing flow.
