The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste=24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle=10 tons, 4 containers of construction and demolition=12 tons and 1 container of mixed scrap metal. Compost pile was turned, and the brush pile was burned. Car counts Monday 352, Tuesday 358, Friday 455, Saturday 345 Sunday 287 total 1,797 residents served.

Public Safety

Moultonborough Police Department: The Moultonborough Police Department recorded 206 log entries, which included the following calls for service, 2 Assist Citizens, 10 Motor Vehicle Stops, 15 Assists to Fire/EMS, 0 Directed Patrols, 1 Arrest, 4 complaints, 2 MV Accidents, 5 MV Complaints, 2 Residential Alarms, 1 Commercial Alarms, and 0 K-9 complaints.

Training: MPO Cortese attended Oxygen Forensic Digital Extraction Sept 13 thru 15th. SRO Christen Cloutier attended TAC Emergency Casualty Care Sept 17th and 18th.

Moultonborough Fire Department: For the period of 09/12/2022 to 09/18/2022, there were twenty-two calls for service: There was: 1 – Forest, woods or wildland fire, 1 – Excessive heat, scorch burns with no ignition, 14 – EMS incidents, 2 – Public assistance, 1 – Dispatched & canceled en-route, 1 – Smoke detector activation, no fire, unintentional, 1 – Carbon monoxide detector activation, no CO. **Total 2022 Incidents: 760. Automatic Aid:** received four times from Stewart's Ambulance. Once given to Meredith. **Mutual Aid:** none. **Overlapping Incidents:** 4 **Year to Date:** 139. **Percentage of Call Volume:** 19%. Overlapping incidents are where two or more incidents are occurring simultaneously.

If you are burning wood, you need a fire permit. 2022 Fire permits are available at the Public Safety Building and on-line at www.NHFirepermit.com. The fee for an online fire permit is \$5.50. Property owners with rental properties are reminded that "written permission" must be given to anyone renting the property to kindle a fire on the property being rented. The letter of permission must indicate the category of fire allowed and the duration in which the renter is permitted to kindle the fire.
