The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste = 36 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycle = 10 tons and 5 containers of construction and demolition = 25 tons. 77 Freon containing units were recovered, brush pile burned, and compost pile turned.
