The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

### Department of Public Works

**Transfer Station:** This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste = 36 tons, 3 containers of single stream recycle = 15 tons and 4 containers of construction and demolition = 24 tons. The full electronics container was swapped out, brush pile was burned.

Municipal solid waste compactor # 2 caught on fire, caused by some type of ignition source tossed into the compactor by a resident. Moultonborough Fire Department was called in to extinguish the garbage bags after the contents were dumped on the ground.

Thanks to the Moultonborough Fire Dept. for their quick response and staying after the fire to illuminate the area while the facility staff cleaned up the burned garbage.
