The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Public Safety

4/18 The Day shift conducted a fire sprinkler system and fire alarm system inspection at 130 Whittier Highway. EMS Continuing Education was held, CPR recertification class was led by Paramedic John Burdette.

4/19 The Department received dealer training from Dan Felix of Firematic Supply Co. on the new Res-Q-Jack Apex vehicle stabilizing struts and jacks. In the past month, the fire department has received over \$70,000 of rescue equipment from funds donated to the Fire Department.

4/20 Chief Bengtson, Lt. Frangelli and firefighter Houghton participated in a webinar from Vector Solutions for a staff scheduling program.

Burning Permits: Effective April 1, 2023, Fire permits are required for open burning, including campfires, and burning brush. Fire Permits may be obtained at the Public Safety Building located at 1035 Whittier Highway or online at www.NHFirePermit.com. Or at <https://nh.burnsafeamerica.com/>

The Daily Fire Danger forecast can be obtained by calling the Division of Forests and Lands wildfire information line (toll free): 1-866-NH-FIRES (866-643-4737). The Daily Fire Danger is also posted on the Smokey Bear sign outside the Public Safety Building.

RSA 125-N:4 prohibits the residential open burning of combustible domestic waste. " Combustible domestic waste " means combustible waste such as, but not limited to, household trash, packaging materials, plastics, coated or laminated papers, rubber, painted, or treated wood, coated, or treated cardboard, oily rags, and animal, vegetable, and kitchen waste. The term does not include untreated wood, leaves, brush, or paper products generated at a residence.
