The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

### Department of Public Works

**Transfer Station:** This week we shipped out 2 containers of municipal solid waste = 24 tons, 2 containers of single stream recycling = 10 tons, 8 containers of construction and demolition = 40 tons and one container of mixed scrap metal.

The compost pile will be screened this coming week then it will be ready for the residents to pick up. The compost pile was turned, brush pile burned. The 42yard packer boxes that are used to contain the trash and recyclables are being serviced and repaired with facility staff.
