The following report from town departments provides an update for the Board of Selectmen on the various programs, initiatives, projects, and upcoming events.

Department of Public Works

Highway: The highway crew continues with ditching along several roads. The team also assisted with a cemetery burial.

Facilities/Grounds: The crew continues with weekly cemetery and grounds maintenance, as well as boat ramp and beach clean-up.

Road Program: Crack sealing and chip sealing is anticipated to begin within the next couple of weeks.

Facilities Paving Project: GMI Asphalt has substantially completed the facilities paving project with a few minor paving adjustments needing to be done.

Transfer Station: This week we shipped out 3 containers of municipal solid waste (36 tons), 2 containers of single stream recycling (10 tons), 9 containers of construction and demolition (45 tons) and 1 container of mixed scrap metal.

Brush pile was burned, compost pile turned, 130 Freon containing devices had their gas extracted, the old land fill / field grass was cut, and compactor #2 power unit was replaced.
