Join the Moultonborough Heritage Commission and Geneva Point Center on Saturday, June 11th for a tour of 'Historic Barns and Camps of Moultonborough Neck' and evening Pig Roast Summer Kick Off celebration with music and dancing!

The event starts at 11 AM at Geneva Point Center, with a talk on NH Barns by John Porter, co-author of *Preserving Old Barns: Preventing the Loss of a Valuable Resource*, followed by lunch and touring of the recently restored Barn and other historic buildings on site. Self-guided touring of two landmark barns at Camp Tecumseh and three private barns on Moultonborough Neck Road will be from 1-4 PM, followed by a Social Hour and the Pig Roast Summer Kick Off.

This collaborative event celebrating barns and local history is organized in association with the NH Preservation Alliance, the statewide non-profit organization helping people to preserve historic buildings, landscapes and communities.
