We, the School Board members of the School district of the Town of Moultonborough, do herewith create a trust fund to receive donations, <sup>private</sup> ~~and public~~, to be placed under the care of Trustees of the Trust Funds of the Town of Moultonborough, for the benefit of the students and educators participating in environmental projects.

This Trust fund is to be herein known as the **Miller Environmental Education Fund**. (MEEF)

The Superintendent and Board will appoint a project manager and a minimum of four additional members from the community that could include SAU employees, Representatives of the Natural Science Center of New Hampshire, and/or Project Home. This group is to be called the MEEF Committee and the members are to be appointed on a rotating basis.


The Trust may receive monies from future donations by, to, through, or in behalf of the Miller Environmental Education Fund.


The purpose of this fund is to honor the dedication and passion of Michele Miller, Principal and Educator in the Town of Moultonborough for 34 years. MEEF is a fund to promote the environmental education of children of all ages. The fund may be used to enhance the environmental educational opportunities for the children of Moultonborough. The fund may also be used for school activities that further the experience and support the environmental awareness of these children.


Funds are awarded by completing an application and submitting it to the Project manager for MEEF Committee review. The criteria for the awarding of grants are found in the application.






