ARTICLE 2: Are you in favor of the adoption of the amendment for the existing Town Zoning Ordinance as proposed by the Planning Board as follows: renaming Article 10.0 from Small Wind Energy Systems Ordinance to Energy Systems Ordinances, renaming Section 10.1 to Small Wind Energy Systems Ordinance (previously 10.0), and adding a new Section 10.2, that establishes a Solar Facilities Ordinance that will accommodate solar energy collection systems and distributed generation resources in appropriate locations throughout Town, while protecting the public's health, safety, and welfare? The ordinance facilitates the State and National goals of developing clean, safe, renewable energy resources in accordance with the enumerated policies of NH RSA 374-G and 362-F that include national security and economic and environmental sustainability. The solar collection system ordinance will be enacted in accordance with NH RSA 674:17(l)(i) and the purposes outlined in NH RSA 672:1-III-a as amended.
