REGARDING

SIGNS AND ELECTIONEERING AT THE POLLING PLACE

SIGNS

I would like to remind all citizens, candidates, and supporters of the limitations that apply to political signs at our polling place during every election. The only signs that are permitted at the polling place, or on the Moultonborough Life Safety Building property, are those that are held by the supporters or candidates within the designated electioneering area. Unattended signs within the electioneering area, and any signs outside of that area, including, without limitation, signs affixed to or mounted on vehicles in the parking area (other than those that are parked temporarily while the owner is voting), are prohibited.

ELECTIONEERING

Voters must have a clear path starting from the parking lot and leading to and from the railed in voting area which they can pass through without having to go around or avoid other activities. This path will be free from **any** electioneering activities.

There will be a designated electioneering zone to accommodate candidates and supporters where attended signs can be displayed. **This is the only area where electioneering will be allowed.** Voters must be able to come to the polling place, cast his or her vote and leave without having to avoid or turn away from electioneering activities.
